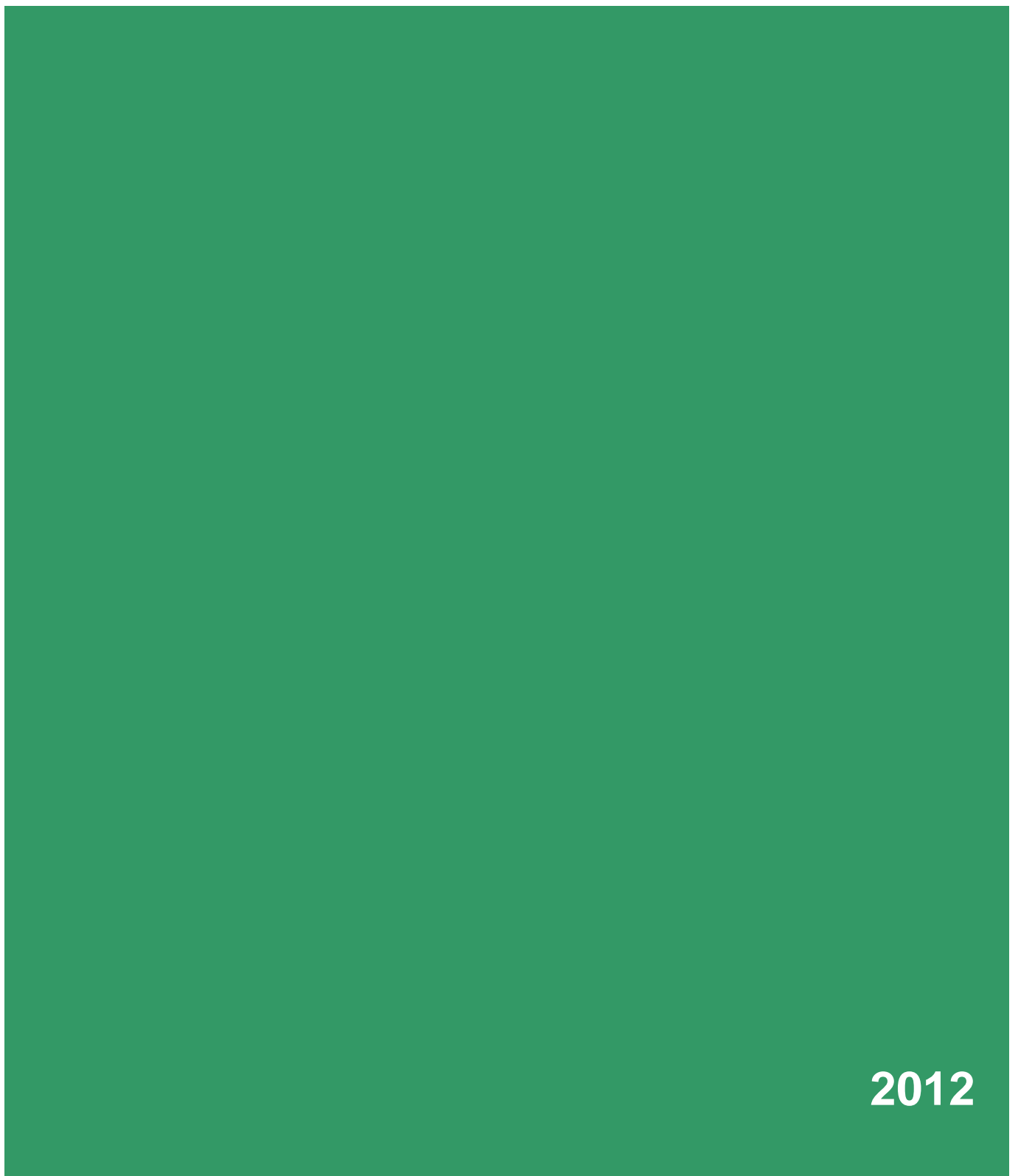


NASES Membership Benefits



NASES membership demonstrates your institution's commitment to professional management and development within the field of student employment. Membership provides your organisation with access to a wide range of benefits, specific services and tailored privileges, including:

Professional Status

NASES membership recognises you as a student employment professional and demonstrates your organisation's commitment to the student employment sector. Your institution can demonstrate NASES membership and professional status by using the NASES membership logo on service promotional materials and stationery (logo and usage guidelines can be found on www.nases.org.uk/memb). In addition, you will be provided with a NASES Membership certificate to display in your service area. Your service details and a link to your institution and service will be displayed in the NASES Job Shop listing on the NASES web site.

Communication

Members will receive the NASES Newsletter each quarter and a monthly e-news update. The website is updated regularly with a member's only section, and the jiscmail mail base is also used for discussion.

Regional Networking

This provides opportunities for services to take part in regular events and online discussions with other services in their region. Members have the opportunity to meet, share ideas, experiences and discuss relevant issues with other student employment professionals on a frequent basis.

NASES Website

To provide members with access to a wealth of intelligence that will enhance your service operation.
